

# Is Your Child on the Right Track?

Georgia law requires all children attending a childcare center or school be up-to-date on required vaccines.

## Recommended well-child visits and vaccines\*

Use this chart to keep your child on track for well-child visits and vaccines.

Be sure your child goes to all recommended well-child visits. Your child's doctor will check his development at each visit. If your child misses a well-child visit, call his doctor to reschedule.

Your child will sometimes get vaccines, also called shots or immunizations, at those visits. These vaccines will help keep your child from getting sick.

Your child's doctor will track his vaccines. Keep an updated copy of your child's vaccine record. Give a copy of the updated record to the childcare center or school.
