2009 Spring Classic for Kids

Georgia vs. Georgia Tech at Turner Field, May 12

The UGA-GT Challenge for Children's Healthcare of Atlanta is a ticket sales fundraising campaign benefiting Children's through the annual Spring Classic for Kids at Turner Field. The event features two of college baseball's national powers and rivals, Georgia and Georgia Tech, playing each other for state bragging rights.

More than 100 volunteers from various companies participated in the 2008 UGA-GT Challenge for Children's, helping us sell 22,000 tickets and raise \$200,000 to benefit our pediatric healthcare system. Volunteers helped sell group ticket packages ranging in value from \$100 to \$5,000 to their corporate contacts and vendors of their companies in the weeks leading up to the game. Children's handles all of the orders, including payment processing and distribution of tickets.

Children's is looking to expand the number of companies in the 2009 UGA-GT Challenge to help make this the largest college baseball game in NCAA history. Volunteers do not need to be alumni of the universities. Our goal is for each company to help raise a minimum of \$2,000 in sponsor ticket packages sold.
