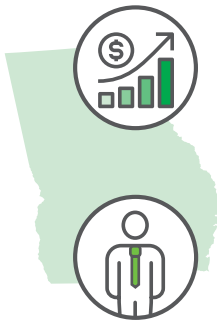


Our Economic Impact

Children's Healthcare of Atlanta is one of the largest pediatric clinical care providers in the country and the only children's hospital in the state ranked nationally by U.S. News & World Report. Children's is Georgia's sole provider of many pediatric treatments and services, and we address significant patient demand for services that could not be met by other in-state providers.

Our statewide economic contribution



We generate \$6.12 billion in economic output.

- For every \$1 generated by Children's, another \$1.18 is brought into Georgia's economy.
- In the past 10 years, our economic impact has grown by 65%.



We employ 12,000 full-time equivalent jobs.

- Our operations support 30,000 jobs through direct, indirect and associated spending.
- Every job at Children's supports another 1.46 jobs in Georgia's economy.
- In the past 10 years, our employment has increased by 17%.

Construction of Arthur M. Blank Hospital

The construction of Children's newest facility, Arthur M. Blank Hospital, brought additional revenue into Georgia's economy:

- It supported **thousands of jobs** and generated **half a billion dollars** in wages.
- From 2020 to 2024, the project generated an annual net fiscal impact of **\$14.7 million** for the State of Georgia.



What happens without Children's?

Children's brings significant economic activity to the state that would not otherwise exist in its absence.



Without Children's, **55% of our patients** would leave the state for care.

Without Children's, **16,500 jobs** would move.

Without Children's, **\$3.36 billion** would be invested elsewhere.

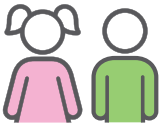

We care for kids from all 159 counties.

- Approximately **one out of every six kids** in Georgia comes to Children's every year.
- We are **one of the largest providers of Medicaid services** in the state; approximately 55% of our patients are covered by Medicaid, PeachCare for Kids, or are unable to cover the cost of care.

Five things to know about Children's

1. Children's is one of the top pediatric healthcare systems in the nation.
2. Children's is much more than a hospital; it is a System of multiple locations serving the entire state.
3. Children's is known for taking care of kids' bodies, but they take care of kids' minds, too.
4. Of the more than 3,000 kids who visit Children's each day, more than half of them need financial assistance.
5. It costs \$7.5 million a day to run Children's. This can't be done without serious community and government support.
