What is a reasonable goal for my personal fundraising page?

There are a number of aspects that play into what makes a reasonable fundraising goal. Before setting a fundraising goal, examine your audience. If you believe that the average donation will be around \$20, we suggest multiplying \$20 by the number of individuals you plan to solicit. If you expect for the average donation to be around \$100, then the same rule applies.

<u>Average Expected Donation</u> X <u>Number of individuals you are asking</u> = <u>Goal</u>

If you plan on soliciting donations through social media, we encourage you to challenge yourself and your social media followers to goal that you feel is a stretch and you would be proud to accomplish. Remember, "Shoot for the moon. Even if you miss, you'll land among the stars."
