Changes to outpatient rehab services



What your practice needs to know

After performing an in-depth analysis of our outpatient rehabilitation resources, Children's Healthcare of Atlanta has determined our most important role in the community is to ensure children with complex medical conditions receive the care they need as there are often very few, if any, pediatric options in the market. With this in mind, we have decided to move to a more consolidated approach so we can shift our focus more to children with complex conditions. As part of this decision, Children's will consolidate outpatient rehabilitation services currently offered at six of our neighborhood locations to our remaining three sites.

When are these changes taking place?

These changes will take place by Dec. 31, 2019.

Which locations are impacted?

The locations impacted include Children's at Alpharetta Highway, Children's at Mount Zion, Children's at Sandy Plains, Children's at Forsyth, Children's at Fayette and Children's at Satellite Boulevard.

What services are impacted?

Audiology and outpatient rehabilitation will no longer be offered at these locations. Note, sports medicine physical therapy will still be offered at all current locations expect Children's at Sandy Plains. Sports medicine physical therapy at our Sandy Plains office will move to Children's at Town Center Outpatient Care Center.

Where can my patients go for outpatient rehabiliation services in the future?

Children's will continue to offer audiology and outpatient rehabilitation at the following locations:

Are any locations closing?

With the consolidation of services, Children's will close Children's at Alpharetta Highway and Children's at Mount Zion. Services at Children's at Sandy Plains, to include sports medicine physical therapy and orthotics and prosthetics, will move to Children's at Town Center Outpatient Care Center. Additionally, orthotics and prosthetics at Children's at Mount Zion will move to Children's at Fayette.

Children's at Forsyth, Children's at Fayette and Children's at Satellite Boulevard will remain open and continue to offer other pediatric specialty services.
