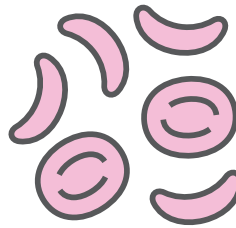


Employs **more than 130** faculty members—**more than 7 times** our size in 2000—and more than **50** advanced practice providers

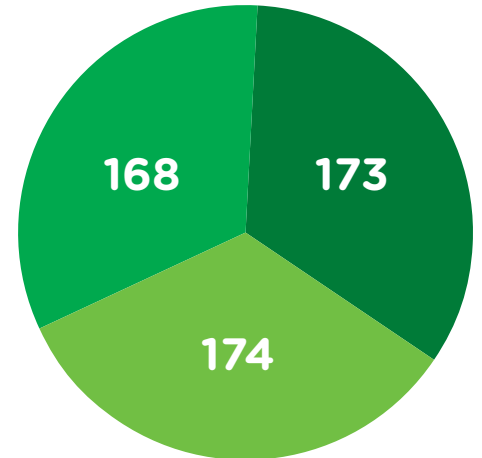
Treated more than **10,000** patients across three campuses

Cared for **2,288 kids** in our Cancer Survivor Program from 2021 to 2025



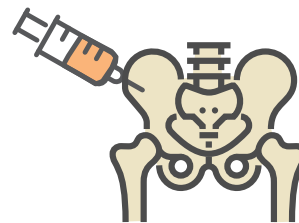
Legend: Liquid tumor (light green), Brain tumor (medium green), Solid tumor (dark green)

Our **Precision Medicine Program** allows for genomic profiling of high-risk tumors to tailor clinical care

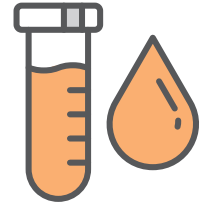

One of approximately **21 premier pediatric oncology programs** making up the **COG Phase I and Pilot Consortium**



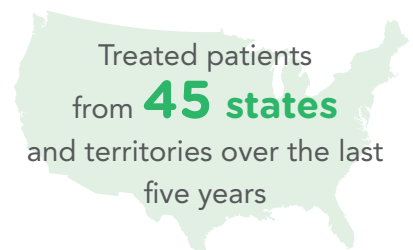

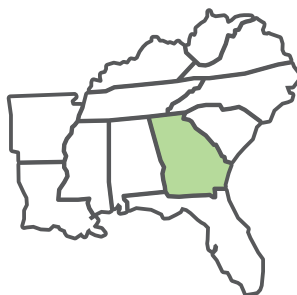
