## Seven key impacts to ICD-10 documentation

- 1. Disease or disorder site
- 2. Acuity and/or encounter status of treatment
- 3. Etiology, causative agent, or disease type and injury/ poisoning cause, intent, activity at the time of the event and place event occurred
- 4. Underlying and associated conditions
- 5. Manifestations
- 6. Complications or adverse events
- 7. Supporting info such as lab values or socioeconomic key impacts to ICD-10 documentation
