Changes to outpatient rehab services



What your family needs to know

In an effort to optimize the care we provide for our patients and their families and to ensure we are delivering the best experience, Children's has made the decision to consolidate outpatient rehabilitation services currently offered at six of our neighborhood locations to our remaining three sites.

When are these changes taking place?

These changes will take place by Dec. 31, 2019.

Which locations are impacted?

The locations impacted include Children's at Alpharetta Highway, Children's at Mount Zion, Children's at Sandy Plains, Children's at Forsyth, Children's at Fayette and Children's at Satellite Boulevard.

Is the service my child needs impacted?

Audiology and outpatient rehabilitation (occupational therapy, physical therapy and speech) will no longer be offered at these locations.

Where can my child go for these services in the future?

Children's will continue to offer outpatient rehabilitation services at our following three locations:

Are any locations closing?

With the consolidation of services, Children's will close Children's at Alpharetta Highway and Children's at Mount Zion. Services at Children's at Sandy Plains, to include sports medicine physical therapy and orthotics and prosthetics, will move to Children's at Town Center Outpatient Care Center. Additionally, orthotics and prosthetics at Children's at Mount Zion will move to Children's at Fayette.

Children's at Forsyth, Children's at Fayette and Children's at Satellite Boulevard will remain open and continue to offer other pediatric specialty services.

- **Children's at Forsyth**: Endocrinology, general surgery, orthopedics and sports medicine, orthotics and prosthetics, scoliosis screening, sports medicine physical therapy, urgent care, lab and X-ray
- **Children's at Fayette**: ENT, general surgery, orthopedics and sports medicine, orthotics and prosthetics, and sports medicine physical therapy
- **Children's at Satellite Blvd**: Endocrinology, ENT, gastroenterology, general surgery, hepatology, lab and radiology, outpatient surgery, rheumatology, scoliosis screening, sleep lab, urgent care
