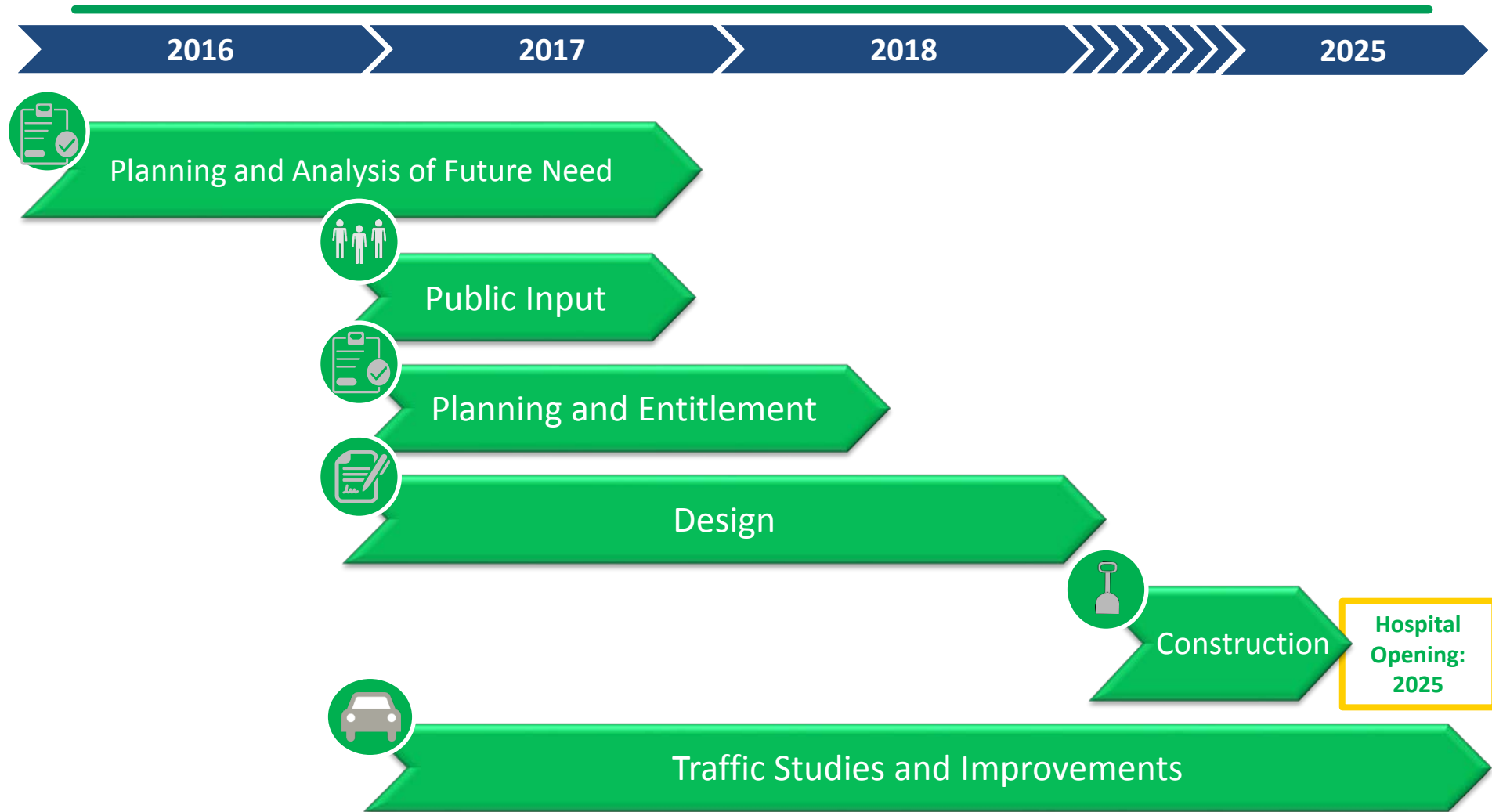

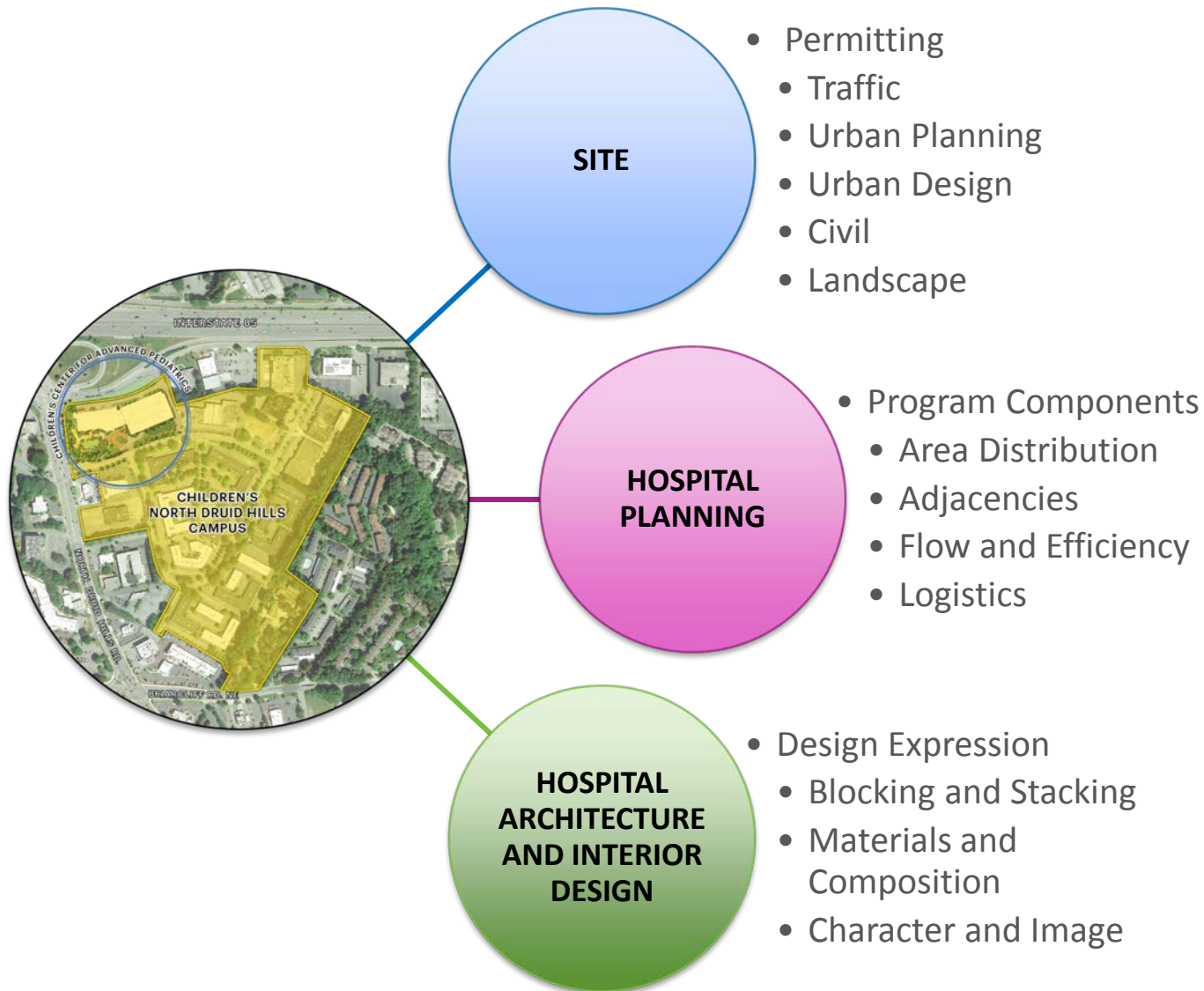

Regional Flow:

- Bus and car movement around the campus
- Interstate, Frontage Road, North Druid Hills and Briarcliff Road



Within Campus



Public Access:

- Patients and Family
- Visitors
- Clear front door
- Direct connection to public and ED parking



Staff Access:

- Direct connection to staff parking



Ambulance Access:

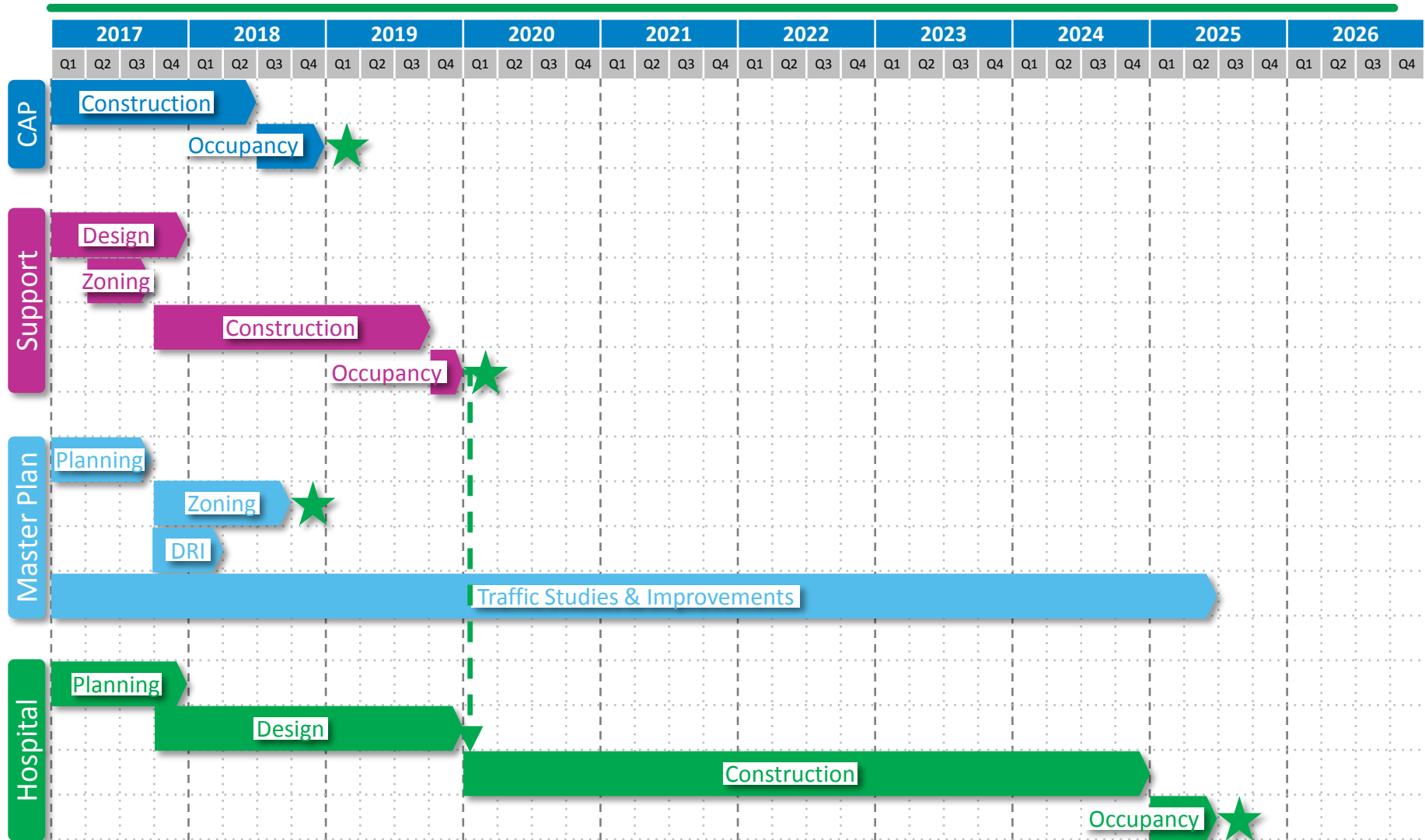
- Direct path to ED
- No conflict with other movement



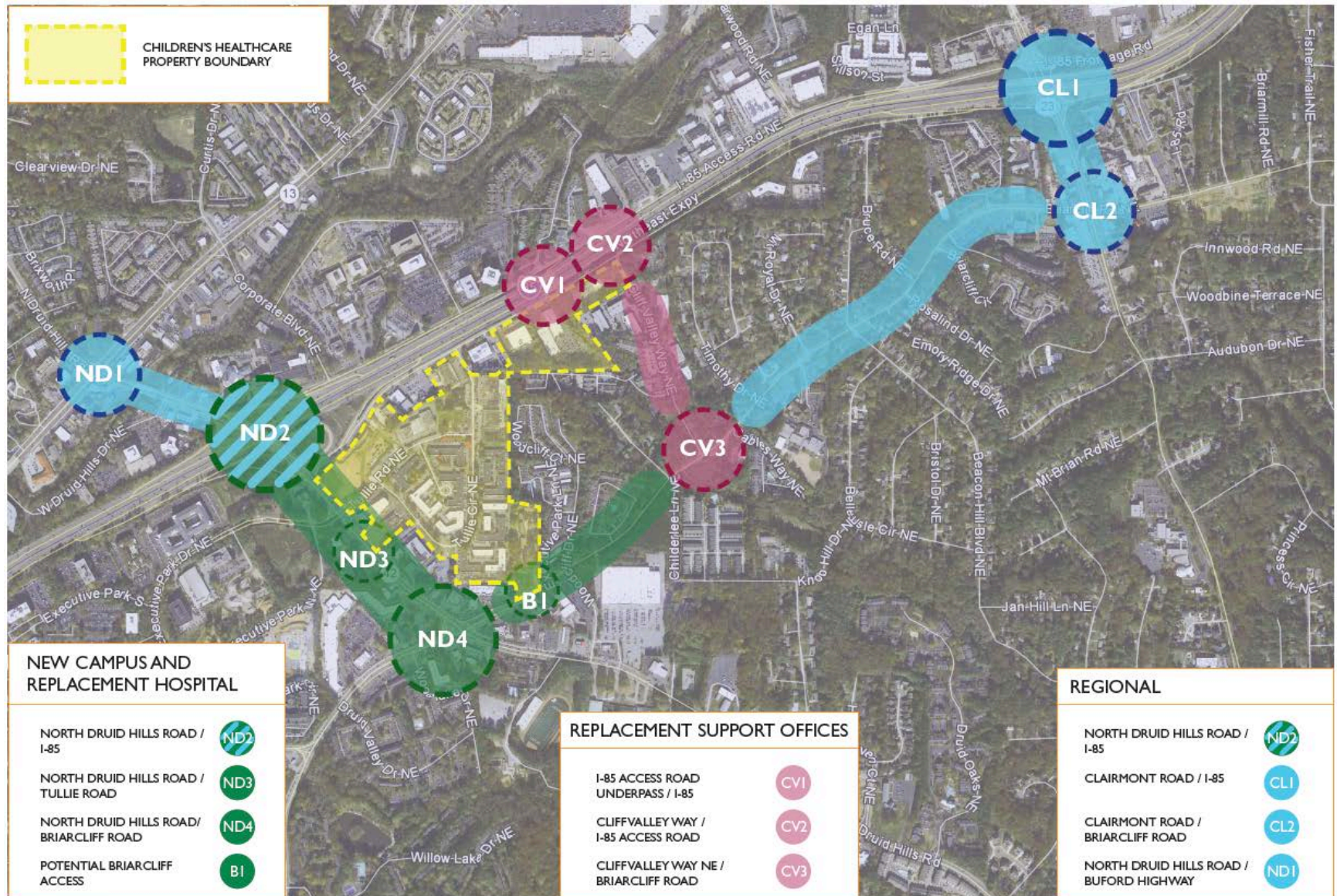
Service Access:

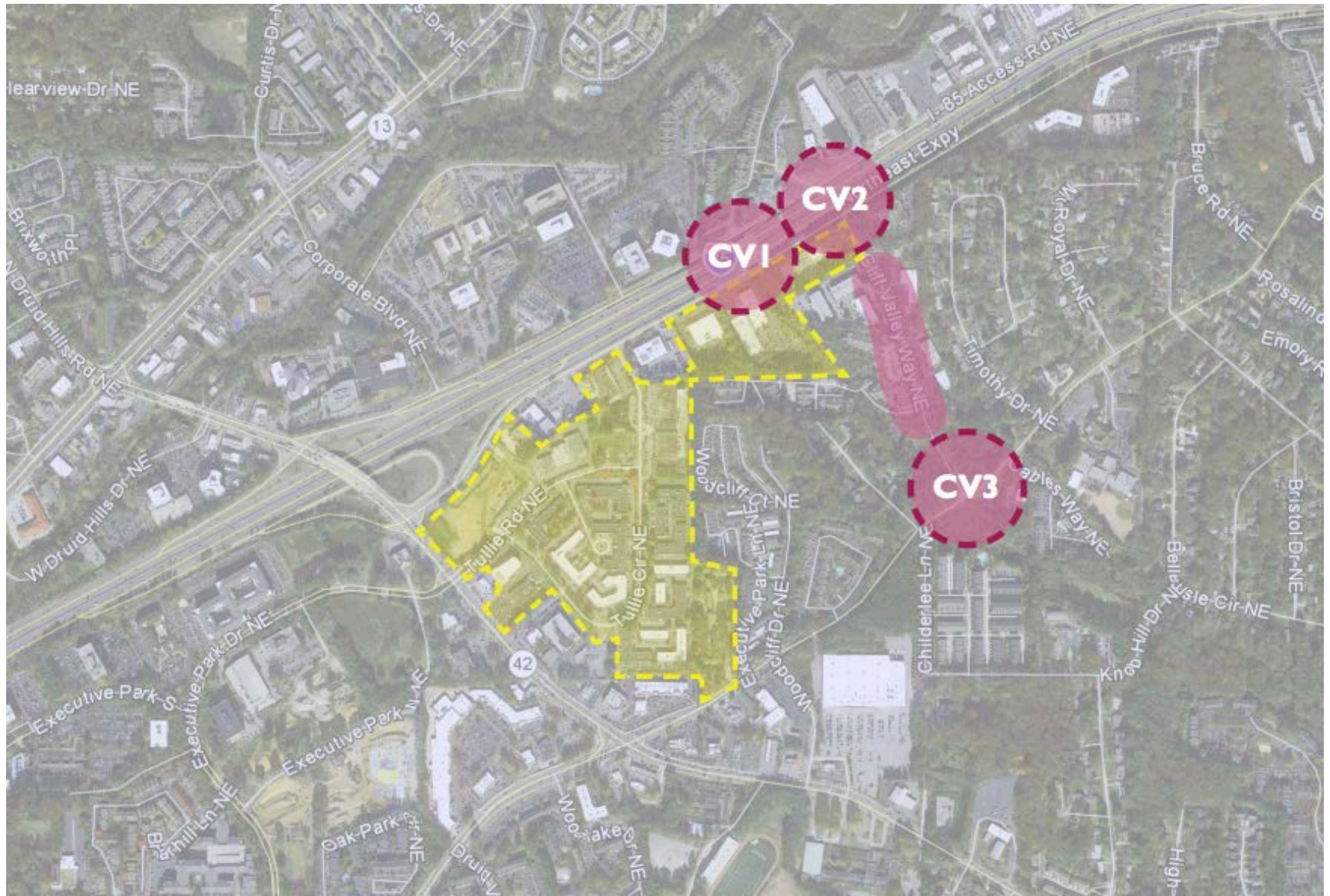

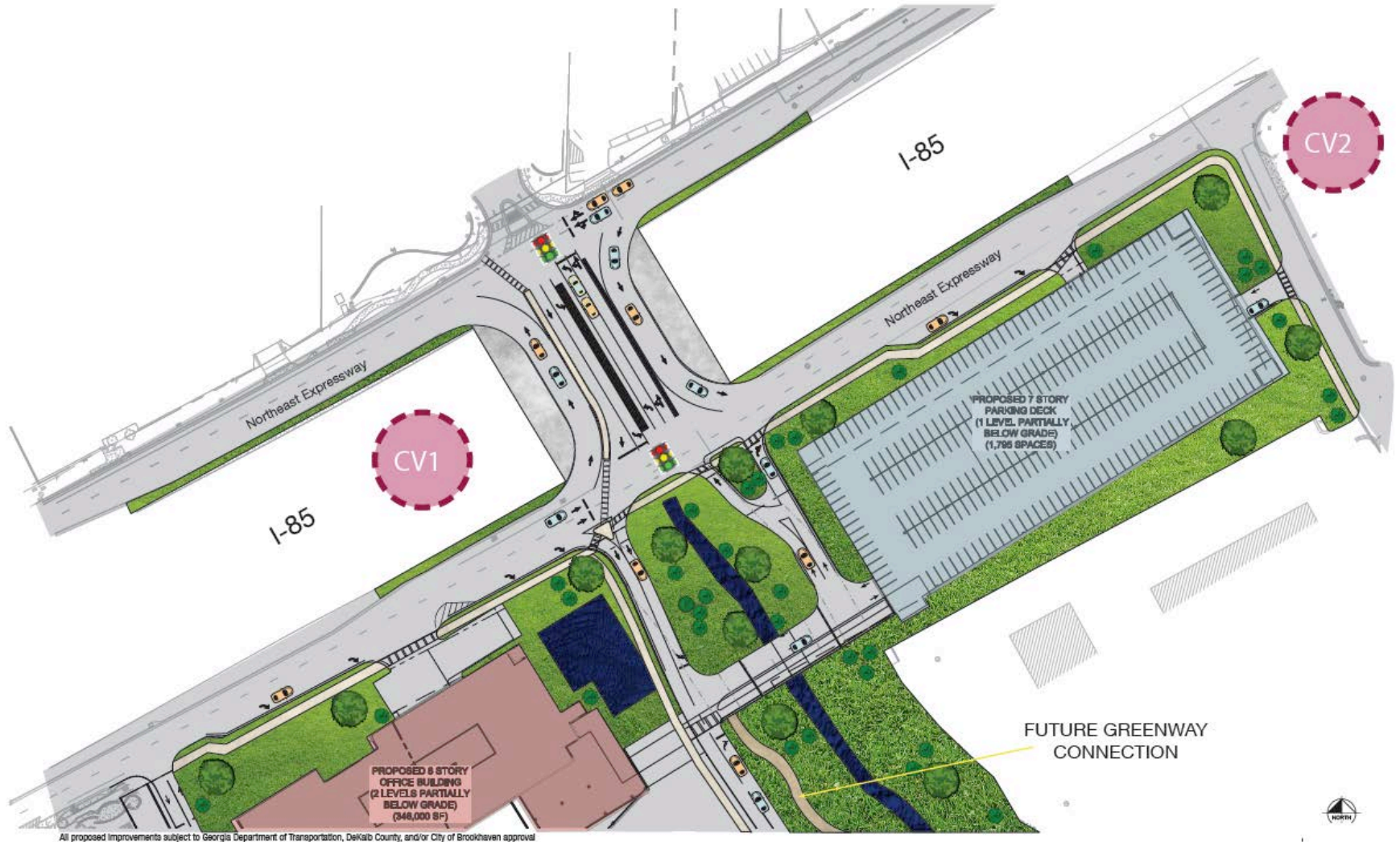

Proposed Improvements Overview



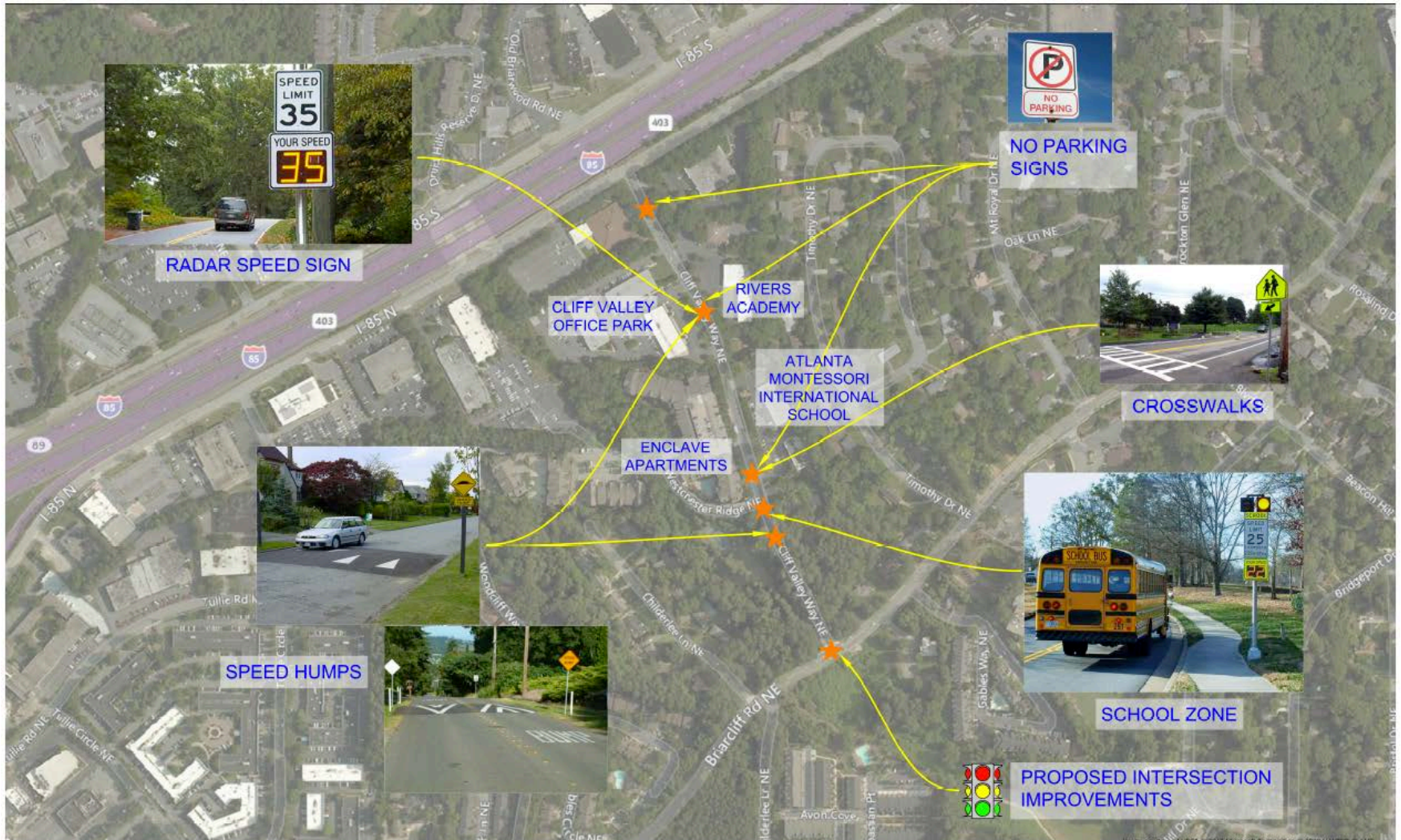
Frontage Road



I-85 Underpass

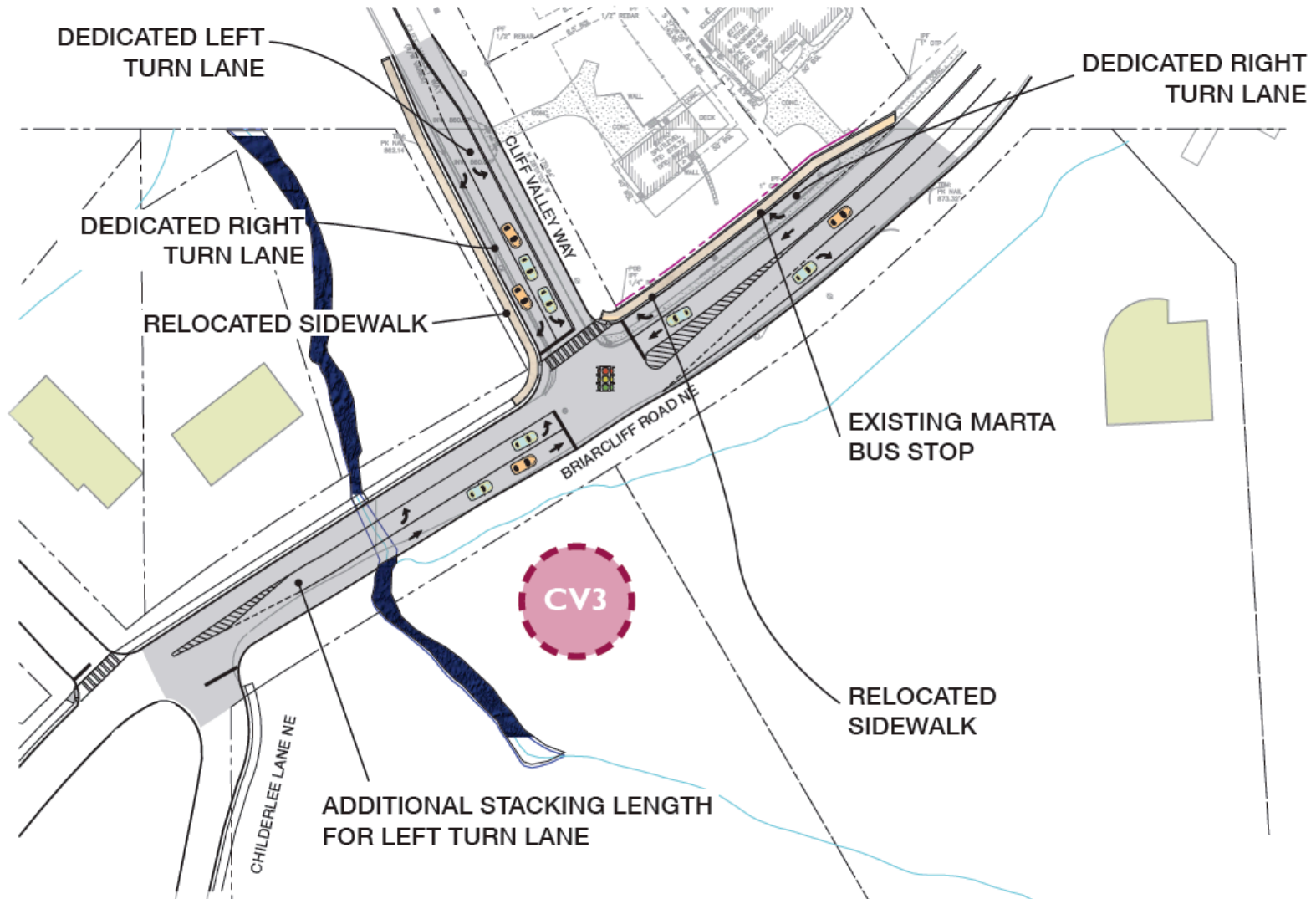


Cliff Valley Way
