#### What is Beyond the Classroom?

The Child Life Department at Children's Healthcare of Atlanta offers a two-day training seminar for students in child life academic programs. This seminar was established in 1994 to provide an opportunity to hear first-hand from child life specialists and participate in learning opportunities through role-playing, interactive discussion, and hands-on exploration.

#### What is a certified child life specialist?

According to the Association of Child Life Professionals (ACLP), "Certified Child Life Specialists are educated and clinically trained in the developmental impact of illness and injury. Their role helps improve patient and family care, satisfaction, and overall experience. Infants, children and youth confront a wide variety of stressful and potentially traumatic events that can impact their ability to cope. These experiences related to healthcare can lead to feelings of fear, confusion, loss of control, and isolation that can inhibit their development and have negative effects on their physical and emotional health and well-being. In both healthcare and community settings, Certified Child Life Specialists help infants, children, youth, and families cope with the stress and uncertainty of acute and chronic illness, injury, trauma, disability, loss, and bereavement. They provide evidence-based, developmentally and psychologically appropriate interventions including therapeutic play, preparation for procedures, and education to reduce fear, anxiety, and pain."
